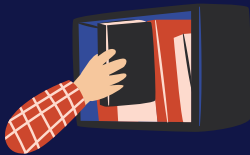
Important!

Minimum grade of "C" required for all CS and thread courses



39-hour Rule: Your degree requires at least 21 credit hours of upper division (3000-4000) courses in the major field and at least 39 credit hours of upper division work overall. *Visit the resource link for additional details on this rule's impact on some thread combinations*

36-hour rule: The final 36 credit hours required for the degree must be earned in residence at Georgia Tech and approved by the major school



Pass/Fail courses are only eligible for up to 6 hours of free elective credit
CS 1100 is only offered pass/fail

Grade Substitution: Undergraduate students may repeat for grade substitution up to two GT courses with grades D or F. These courses will be excluded from GPA calculation. A course can be taken for grade substitution only once and must be repeated within one calendar year. The application must be filed with the Registrar's Office no later than the withdrawal deadline during the student's next term of enrollment after the course is repeated.

APPH/HPS Credit is the only "Wellness Requirement" accepted
